## HELPFUL HINTS – BIMINI ALL-AROUND LIGHT

Are you going to put your all around (anchor) light on top of your bimini?

- On a new bimini, you need to thread 2 wires through the rear bow (usually on the right side) to the center of the top bow when you assemble the bimini frame.\*
- Drill a <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" hole to exit your wire from inside the frame. Protect your wire from sharp edges with a grommet or a few wraps of electrical tape.
- Install a folding all around light, (Part Number: 23-5358127) which will do an excellent job.
- We suggest that you use a plug (Part Number: 50-13841) at the hinge point of your bimini at the rail to make the removal of your bimini easy.

\* Left and right of a pontoon are determined by standing on your pontoon facing the direction of travel. In boating terms, left is "port", right is "starboard."
